COMPETITION REPORT

Lincolnshire Teams Competition 23rd September 2019

Two teams entered a huge Level 5 team competition. One team, Freya Byers, Lola Gurnhill, Laila Hall and Atenna Mohammadi finished 9th, with Freya and Lola individually passing Level 5. The second team was made up of only three gymnasts: Amy Christofi, Isla McGinn & Isabella Redgwell, due to injury, and they finished a very commendable 15th. Neve McGinn and Libby Minta moved up to Level 4, to make a team of three with Brooke Spencer, and they all performed well with each score counting to finish 7th.

Lincolnshire Floor & Vault competition – 13th October 2019

Atenna Mohammadi competed in the 8 years age group and performed well to finish 2nd and win the silver medal. Lacey Taylor competed in the 9 years age group & performed well to finish 2nd and win the silver medal (and qualify for the Lincolnshire team to compete in the regional team finals in December). In the 10 years age group Madeline Enderby placed 11th, Chloe Verrall 15th and Emma Mitchell 16th. In the 11 years age group Hanna Klab placed 9th, Amelie Bogg 10th and Rosie Niner 11th. Amy Christofi placed 4th in the 14 years age group. All the girls performed well and were a credit to the club.

Regional Open Age Level 4 – 27th October 2019

Three gymnasts, Brooke Spencer, Neve McGinn and Katie Johnson entered this competition at Leicester. Neve and Brooke (both 12) competed in a very large 12/13 years age group and performed well to finish 24th and 28th respectively.
