## **Club Shop**

Just a reminder that the club shop carries a stock of the recreational and squad leotards that the gymnasts must wear for the competition. They can be sized up and purchased at the beginning/end of training sessions. We also have a stock of the LCGC leggings which match the hoodies available to purchase. Personalised hoodies are available to order. They are available in overhead or zip up. Because they are personalised, they must be paid for at the time of order (the order forms are available at the club so please ask a coach).

### **Spectators at Training**

We are pleased to announce that we will be able to welcome one adult spectator into the gym from Monday 2<sup>nd</sup> May 2022 to watch training. The spectator area and seating is restricted due to adjustments we had to make to the gym due to the previous COVID-19 restrictions, which is why we can only allow one adult per gymnast at this time. Spectators must remain in the seating that will be set out and not encroach onto the sprung floor or other areas of the gym. **No drinks or food must be brought into the gym by spectators**. This is conditional on spectators parking sensibly in the car park, right up to the gym or the car in front and not leaving large gaps between cars. As you know we have had a lot of issues with car parking, particularly from other businesses, and it is important that only the gym's car parking is used if parents/guardians are remaining at the gym to spectate.
