Just a reminder in accordance with our club rules and the rules of our governing body British Gymnastics:

- Gymnasts are to have neat tidy hair and be dressed appropriately with no buttons or zips on their clothing.
- All jewellery is to be removed newly pierced ears can be covered with medical tape for six weeks, after then they need to be removed. Failure to do so will result in the gymnast being unable to train.
- Prior to arriving for their session, gymnasts should arrive ready to train hair neatly tied back and jewellery removed (or covered if within the six week period above). The club accepts no responsibility for personal belongings left at the club.
- All gymnasts should bring a drink in a sports bottle with them, which can be stored in the cubes in the viewing area.

Our gymnasts' safety and wellbeing is a priority. We thank you for understanding and following the club rules. These rules are part of the terms and conditions that you agree to when becoming a member of LCGC.
